

PLACEMENT ON LIGHT STANDARDS

Many people have requested permission to place their signs on street light poles and utility poles. Due to the various number of agencies that have poles within the County, it is difficult to determine which agency has control over the pole in front of your home. It is illegal to install a sign of any kind on a wooden utility pole.

The Sacramento County Department of Transportation maintains control and authority over most street lights. The department has agreed to and authorized the installation of Neighborhood Watch signs on County owned street light poles only if the following procedure is followed.

Signs will be installed for established Neighborhood Watch groups only, and a fee of \$15 will be charged per sign. The Neighborhood Watch group must provide the sign(s). The Department of Transportation will supply all mounting brackets/hardware and the labor to install the sign(s). County forces will not install Neighborhood Watch signs on private property, privately owned street light poles, or on wood posts.

Complete, detach and mail the attached application if you desire to have your Neighborhood Watch sign installed on a County street light pole. Make personal checks payable to Sacramento County, Dept. of Transportation. **YOUR CHECK WILL BE RETURNED TO YOU IF THE STREET LIGHT POLE IN FRONT OF YOUR HOME IS NOT THE PROPERTY OF SACRAMENTO COUNTY.** You must arrange to leave your sign with a neighbor who is home during the day and can give it to the County work crew for installation.
