- Member expressed that they would prefer physical bollards to be used as bike lane separation. Staff agreed to review available widths.
- Member expressed support for southern pedestrian path and was curious of feedback from multifamily residents.
- Given housing density and proximity to the project, member expressed concerns around the lack of a raised median along this segment, as pedestrian crossings are likely to occur at unsignalized/uncontrolled crossing areas.

Summary: Sacramento County Department of Transportation has identified six potential bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure project candidates to be considered for grant funding applications for the California Transportation Commission/Caltrans Active Transportation Program Cycle 7 (CTC/ATP) and other grant programs. The project candidates include:

- Whitney Avenue Safe Routes to School
- Madison Avenue Safe Routes to School
- Marconi Avenue Complete Streets
- El Camino Avenue Pedestrian Improvements
- Arden Way Bike and Ped Improvements, Phase 2
- Stockton Boulevard Bicycle and Pedestrian Project, Phase 2

Additional information about each of the six projects can be found in the attached table. The Department aims to submit three grant applications to the CTC/ATP Program.

Funding Source(s): Various grant funding programs including California Transportation Commission/California Department of Transportation Active Transportation Program, Cycle 7; Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG) 2025 Funding Round; US Department of Transportation Safe Streets and Roads for All Program.

Background Information: The CTC/Caltrans Active Transportation Program (ATP) is a competitive statewide program that was created to encourage the increased use of active modes of transportation. Senate Bill 99 and Assembly Bill 101 created the ATP, and Senate Bill 1 directs additional funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account to the ATP. With Federal, SB1, and State Highway Account funding, ATP Cycle 7 is expected to include about \$555 Million. Projects awarded will be funded and programmed from the 25/26 through the 28/29 fiscal years.

Call for projects are anticipated to open in March 2024 and the project applications deadline is anticipated to be in June 2024.
