**SUBJECT: Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) Meeting Notice
Wright Street (Marconi Ave. – Edison Ave.)**

Dear Resident/Property Owner:

The Sacramento County Department of Transportation (SacDOT) has received a petition from residents in your neighborhood requesting speed controls through our Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP).

SacDOT staff has scheduled a neighborhood meeting to receive input from residents and to develop a traffic management plan for Wright Street. The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, February 24, 2010 at 6:30 p.m.** at the **Marconi Service Station**, located at **2500 Marconi Ave Suite 100**. The focus of this meeting will be to create a traffic plan for Wright Street between Marconi Avenue and Edison Avenue.

It is very important that you participate in this process during the development of the traffic management plan by providing your input via attending the meeting, calling, or sending an email. After a traffic plan is developed, a ballot and a copy of the plan will be sent out to both residents and property owners to determine if there is enough support from the neighborhood residents to move forward with the plan. The Board of Supervisors (BOS) adopted NTMP process requires that 50% of residents respond to the ballot and the majority supports the traffic management plan before the BOS can consider the plan for final approval. If the neighborhood achieves the minimum response and approval rates necessary per the BOS approved process, the plan will be considered by the Board of Supervisors for final approval and leading to construction.

We highly encourage you to attend the meeting to provide input into the development of the traffic management plan.
